# **FRC Weekly Report**

#### **BAJAUR AGENCY**

On 3 October 2013, a security man received injures while a militant was killed when unknown miscreants attacked Bajaur levies post in Sheikh Kali area of Tehsil Khar.

On 6 October 2013, like other parts of the country "World Teachers Day" was also observed in the tribal belt of Bajaur Agency to pay rich tribute to the teachers and acknowledge their role and services in nation building.

#### **MOHMAND AGENCY**

On 1 October 2013, a soldier was injured in a Mohmand blast. The blast took place near a check post in Khawazai tehsil of Mohmand Agency. The perpetrators are unidentified and the injured soldier was shifted to a nearby hospital.

On 4 October 2013, three people including two children were killed here in Mohmand Agency on. Sources said unknown assailants open fire on the inmates. As a result daughter and granddaughter of Jalal Khan were killed on the spot.

On 5 October 2013, clerks of the political agent's office and government department boycotted work after security personnel injured one of their colleagues by thrashing at a checkpost in Ekkaghund area of Mohmand Agency.

On 5 October 2013, residents of Kasai and Shati Kor villages, demanded provision of funds for the reconstruction of a bridge on Peshawar-Bajaur Road and repairs of roads in Mohmand Agency.

## **KHYBER AGENCY**

On 1 October 2013, the return process of displaced people to Tirah valley in Khyber Agency gained momentum on Monday as 283 families of Bar Qambarkhel were issued voluntary return forms while another 250 Shalobar families will start their return later.

On 2 October 2013, FATA parliamentarians met Wapda chief and demanded him to provide electricity to Khyber Agency.

On 3 October 2013, an Improvised Explosive Device(IED)planted by unknown militants recovered during construction of Pak-Afghan road and was disposed by the forces here in Zakha khel area of tehsil Landikotal, sub-division of Khyber agency.

On 4 October 2013, the authorities decided to set up more checkposts on the road leading to Bara tehsil of Khyber Agency to keep a vigil on the movement of anti-state elements.

On 6 October 2013, the Education Directorate FATA commemorated the "Salam International Teachers Day" with great zeal and enthusiasm.

#### **KURRUM AGENCY**

On 1 October 2013, a man, who was killed in the Qissa Khwani Bazaar car-bombing, was buried at his ancestral graveyard in Pewar village in Kurram Agency, sources said.

On 4 October 2013, two persons were killed and one was injured in a firing incident during a jirga in Sadda area of Kurram tribal region

On 6 October 2013, a blast took place in Boshera Killay where unknown persons had placed explosives outside the house of one Rehman Ali, whose son Hidayat Ali suffered wounds in the blast. The injured Hidayat Ali was taken to the Agency Headquarters Hospital in Parachinar, where the doctors had to amputate his leg. He was referred to a hospital in Islamabad for further treatment.

On 6 October 2013, a blast occurred in Boshera Jauzak village, where explosives had been planted next to the wall of a house. Two persons identified as Suleman and Zaman sustained injuries in the explosion.

## **ORAKZAI AGENCY**

On 4 October 2013, at least 13 people were killed and 10 injured when a Taliban suicide bomber rammed his explosives-laden vehicle into the house of commander of a rival militant group, Mullah Nabbi Hanafi, in Spin Thall area in Orakzai agency

On 5 October 2013, Political Agent Orakzai Agency narrowly escaped life attempt when unknown armed men opened fire over his convoy from all the four sides while he was en route from Kalaya to Hangu District

#### **NORTH WAZIRISTAN AGENCY**

On September 30 2013, six militants were killed and three injured when missiles fired by a US drone struck a house in Dergah Mandi in North Waziristan. The house caught fire and, according to sources, six people died on the spot and three were wounded.

On 3 October 2013, taliban insisted that the US drone strikes in the country's northwest must stop before they would consider peace talks with the government.

## **SOUTH WAZIRISTAN AGENCY**

On 2 October 2013, The banned Tehreek-e-Taliban Pakistan (TTP) welcomed the appeal of Pakistan's prominent Ulema and Mashaikh for announcing simultaneous ceasefire by the government as well as the TTP to pave the way for congenial atmosphere for peace talks and to end the nine-year-old bloody war.

## **PESHAWAR**

On September 30 2013, in the third savage attack on civilians in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa since the massive suicide blasts at a church in Peshawar, terrorists targeted the busy Qissa Khwani Bazaar in the city on Sunday, killing at least 43 people, including 15 children and three women, and injuring 101.

On September 30 2013, The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa government has decided to launch a targeted operation in Peshawar and other parts of the province after a flurry of suicide bombings over the past one week left more than 140 people dead and hundreds injured.

On September 30 2013, The National Institute of Health (NIH), Islamabad, has confirmed four more polio cases in Federally Administered Tribal Areas They said that three children from North Waziristan Agency and one each from Khyber Agency and Peshawar had tested positive for poliomyelitis. They said that with the fresh cases the number of affected children had now climbed to 24 in Fata and seven in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

On 1 October 2013, Naib Ameer of Jamaat-e-Islami FATA, Zarnor Afridi has demanded federal government to hold local bodies' elections in tribal regions earlier than the provinces as tribesmen would lead themselves towards development and prosperity.

On 2 October 2013, TTP has decided to consider the demands of government in the light of APC. JI has decided to hold an APC on provincial level.

On 2 October 2013, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Assembly adopted a unanimous resolution expressing solidarity with the Christians over the tragic suicide bomb blast at Kohati Gate Church and demanded full protection to the lives and worship places of the minorities in the province

On 3 October 2013, the TESCO chief Pervaiz Swati has asked concerned quarters to set up new feeders and installed new transmission lines to address the issue of low voltage in D.I.Khan, Wana and tribal areas.

On 4 October 2013, the wall of a house in Nishtarabad area was damaged in a grenade attack, in the evening. However, no casualty was reported in the incident.

On 5 October 2013, According to details, a road-side planted bomb targeted a police van in Peshawar's Pishtakhara locality killing a policeman and injuring two others. The police mobile van was partially destroyed in the explosion.

On 5 October 2013, unknown gunmen shot dead a policeman identified as Sajjad Khan in Charsadda's Sar Dheri area. A female student who was passing by was also injured in the incident who was shifted to Lady Reading Hospital for treatment.

On 5 October 2013, unknown assailants gunned down a police head constable at Depot Korona while he was on way to his office on motorcycle

On 6 October 2013, a power pylon was blown up in Khazana while three other bombs planted with the electricity tower were defused.

On 6 October 2013, unidentified miscreants planted a bomb near Army flats in situated in the jurisdictions of Gulberg Police Station. After receiving the information cops reached to spot and called BDU who successfully defused the bomb. BDU officials said that 200 gram explosives were used in the bomb.
