Bajaur Agency

No incident was recorded in the week

Mohmand Agency

On 06 March 2014, a tribesman was killed and another suffered injury when an improvised explosive device (IED) planted in a field near their house went off in Speenkai Saly area of Prang Ghar tehsil.

Khyber Agency

On 03 March 2014, five militants were killed when army's gunship helicopters shelled their hideouts in various areas of Bara Tehsil.

On 04 March 2014, two soldiers of the Frontier Corps (FC) were killed and seven others sustained injuries in a roadside bomb blast in the Zakhakhel area of Landikotal Tehsil.

On 05 March 2014, two drivers were killed and a helper was injured when suspected militants attacked vehicles taking goods for the Afghanistan-based Nato troops in Surkamar area.

Kurram Agency

On 06 March 2014, six soldiers from the paramilitary Frontier Corps (FC) were killed and eight others sustained injuries in a roadside blast in the Ormegi village.

On 06 March 2014, a remote-controlled blast injured three people including two females in Kurram Agency.

On 07 March 2014, the political agent and three other officials of Kurram Agency political administration were injured in an IED blast in Thall tehsil of Hangu district.

Peshawar

On 03 March 2014, Frontier Constabulary personnel was killed in an incident when a passenger coach hit them near Serai Gambila.

On 03 March 2014, a man was killed over domestic dispute in Tajazai village in the limits of Ghaznikhel police station.

On 04 March 2014, the police arrested three outlaws and seized arms during a raid in the limits of Dadiwala Police Station in Lakki Marwat.

On 04 March 2014, a local journalist, Ibrar Tanoli, who was critically injured in an armed attack, succumbed to injuries in Abbottabad hospital in wee hours.

On 05 March 2014, Chief Minister Pervez Khattak on Tuesday said that counter-terrorism department and counter-kidnapping cell were being established in the province to combat terrorism and curb kidnapping for ransom.

On 06 March 2014, assailants killed two persons in Gullibagh area in Mansehra.

On 06 March 2014, a police constable was gunned down near Wazir Bagh in the limits of the Agha Mir Jani Shah Police Station.

On 06 March 2014, unidentified persons shot dead a prayer leader and a police constable in Peshawar.

On 07 March 2014, some unidentified armed men had gunned down Shamsur Rehman, son of Taus Khan, a resident of Adezai area.

On 07 March 2014, to curb the menace of terrorism, kidnapping for ransom and extortion, a Counter Terrorism Directorate (CTD) will be instantly established in Khyber Pakhtukhwa and it will specifically deal with militancy related issues.

On 09 March 2014, the Battal police have arrested a man allegedly involved in target killing in Karachi.

On 09 March 2014, two suspected militants were arrested from the Grand Trunk Road while three alleged extortionists were rounded up in the Faqirabad locality in the Peshawar city.

On 09 March 2014, Militants attacked a team of policemen and the bomb disposal unit (BDU) experts by firing at it and using improvised explosive devices in Sarband village close to the provincial capital.
